Calling in from outside the room? No problem. As long as participants have a connection to the same network and have the PIN to join, they can connect to the meeting and view or share content.

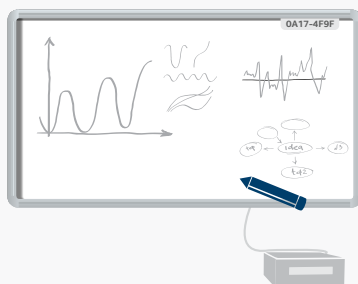
